Report of the EVS board

The financial resources of the Foundation are used to support activities on behalf of the European *Values* Study project. The main activities supported by the Foundation in 2020 concerned substantial contributions to the fieldwork in Montenegro and Latvia, and the production of videos at the occasion of the official data release. Due to Covid-19 pandemic, EVS activities in 2020 were organized online.

The fees received from the full partners are meant for dissemination, valorisation and publicity activities. One of these activities is the maintenance of the EVS website which provides the EVS social networks with information and scientific inputs regarding the study of values across Europe.

Activities financially supported in 2020

Despite the pandemic, several activities were organized in 2020. Since these activities were mainly online, financial support was not required for the workshops and meetings of the main EVS bodies. The support was limited to the production of videos at the occasion of the official release of the 2017 data in an online event on 20 October.

EVS board activities

The EVS Board in its new composition met on 11 November to further discuss the state of the art of the project and progress of the data collection and data release.

Renata van Leeuwaarde resigned from the Board of the Foundation. The Foundation is very grateful for her involvement and great help in drafting the renewed contracts with our partners and other legal affairs over the last years.

Statement of income and expense

Income

In 2020 there were no other revenues than the donations from the full partners.

Expenses

The main expenses were the Foundation's contributions to the fieldwork in Latvia and Montenegro. These were paid from the Porticus donation received in 2017. Further expenditures concerned the videos at the occasion of the official release of the 2017 data in an online event on 20 October.

General

The Foundation European *Values* Study Group has been established in 1981, and aims at supporting the empirical study on human values. Human values are defined as attitudes and value judgments in societies and within certain cultural areas.
