Report of the EVS board

The financial resources of the Foundation are used to support activities on behalf of the European *Values* Study project. The main activity supported by the Foundation in 2022 concerned substantial contributions to the third Atlas of European Values. Luckily, EVS activities in 2022 started to be organized in a hybrid form.

The fees received from the full partners are meant for dissemination, impact and publicity activities. One of these activities is the maintenance of the EVS website which provides the EVS social networks with information and scientific inputs regarding the study of values across Europe.

Activities financially supported in 2022

The Foundation supported publications: the third Atlas of European Values, the first Volume in the open access European Values Series published by Open Press TiU. Also the GA-meeting and workshop were again in person in 2022, and were financially supported.
